2023 RSM Classic Raises More Than \$5.7 Million for Children and Family-Focused Charitable Organizations

Tournament has raised more than \$42 million for those in need since 2010

better) during the FedExCup Fall. Each week, the player with the most birdies (or better) is awarded \$50,000 to donate to the charity of their choice.

Luke List recorded the most birdies (or better) throughout the FedExCup Fall in 2023, which concluded with The RSM Classic, receiving \$300,000 to donate to a children or family-focused charitable organization of his choice. [List made a \\$250,000 donation to Children's Hospital of Georgia](#), and a \$50,000 donation to Ronald McDonald House Charities. Eric Cole was the weekly winner for The RSM Classic and donated his \$50,000 to The McDavid Group Charities Golf for Cops program.

Charitable dollars raised through The RSM Classic are distributed by the RSM US Foundation and the Davis Love Foundation, a 501(c)3 nonprofit organization that manages and operates The RSM Classic. The Davis Love Foundation was established in 2005 by professional golfer and Team RSM Member [Davis Love III](#) and his wife Robin. The foundation contributes to the well-being and progress of society by supporting both national and community-based programs that focus on children and their families. Its mission is to help build a better future for children and their families who are at risk of poor educational, economic, social and health outcomes.
